## THE AUROVILLE FOUNDATION STANDING ORDERS

No. AF/1/2011/Regulations—Whereas Section 11 (3) of the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988, vests the Auroville Foundation's Governing Board with the responsibility for the general superintendence, direction and management of the affairs of Auroville Foundation and to exercise all the powers and discharge all the functions which may be exercised or discharged by the Foundation.

2. Now, therefore, the Governing Board decides that "Standing Orders", not inconsistent with the provisions of the Act, *ibid*, and the Rules made thereunder, and without prejudice to the generality of the laws enacted by Parliament of India and/or the Legislatures of the States and the Union Territories, on all the matters covered by the provisions of Section 11 (3), *ibid* and also such other matters that the Governing Board may consider appropriate and necessary, shall be notified, from time to time, by the Auroville Foundation subject to the following conditions :—

- (a) No Standing Order shall be issued on any of the matters specified in Section 32(2) (a) to (g), *ibid*;
- (b) Chairman shall approve in writing the Standing Order before it is notified;
- (c) Secretary to the Foundation shall notify the Standing Order under his hand and seal;
- (d) Secretary to the Foundation shall arrange to place the notified Standing Order before the Governing Board at its subsequent meeting for endorsement;
- (e) Secretary to the Foundation shall arrange to send copies of the Standing Order, after its notification, to the Central Government (Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education) and to such other authorities and individuals as may be decided by the Chairman from time to time;
- (f) Secretary to the Foundation shall arrange to chronologically number the Standing Orders issued earlier and, for this purpose, shall accordingly renumber the Standing Orders already issued;
- (g) Chairman/Governing Board may amend or revoke a Standing Order as and when considered necessary and appropriate, and, in respect of the amended or revoked Standing Order, Secretary to the Foundation shall follow the steps mentioned at paragraph 4 (a) to 4 (e) *supra*; and
- (h) Secretary to the Foundation shall arrange to maintain a Guard File of all Standing Orders issued and make it available to the members of the Governing Board as and when directed to do so.

3. This regulation shall come into force with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette of India.
